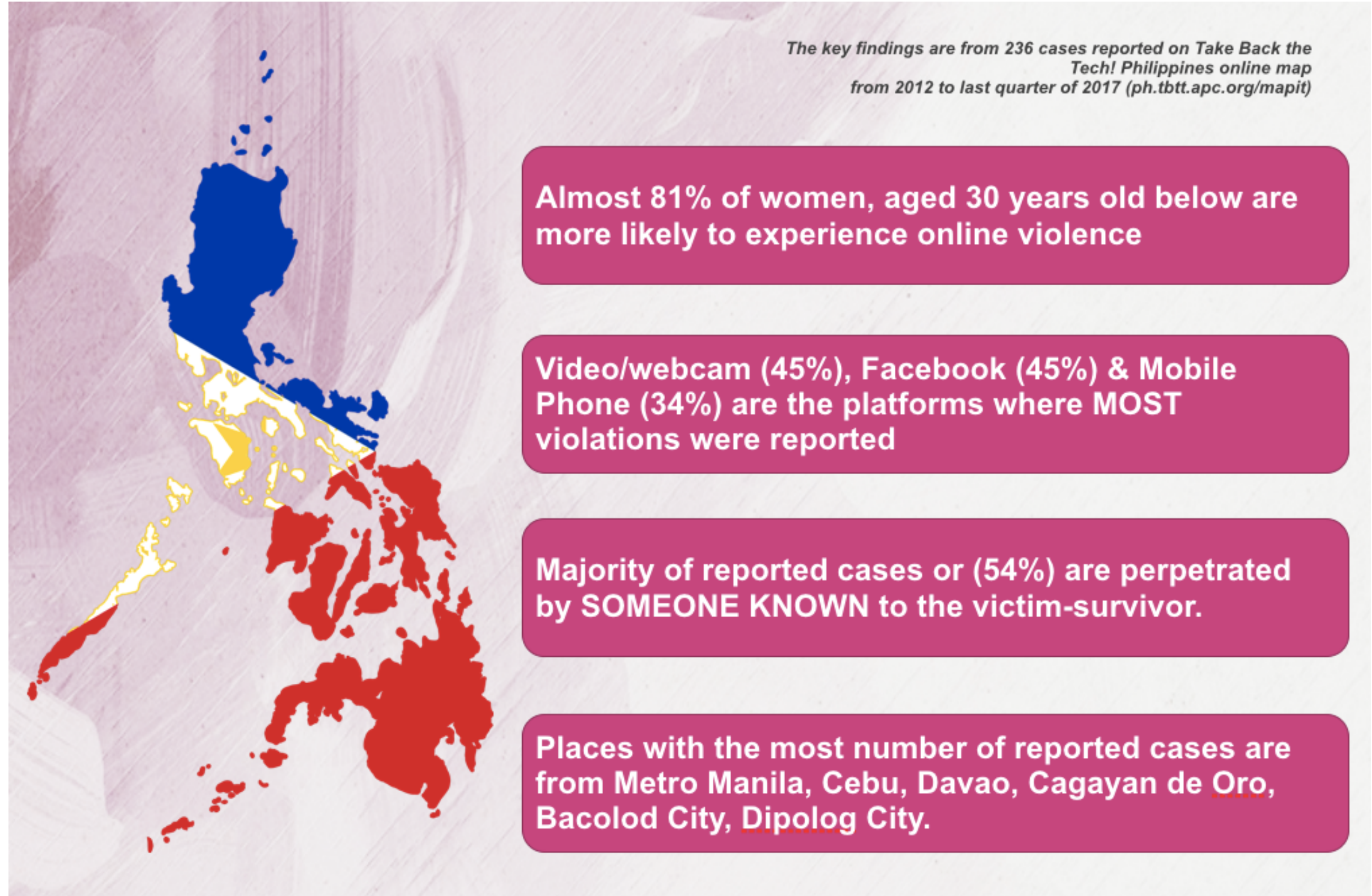
WHAT IS ONLINE GENDER- BASED VIOLENCE?

Online gender-based violence encompasses **acts of gender-based violence that are committed, abetted or aggravated, in part or fully, by the use of information and communication technologies (ICTs)**, such as phones, the internet, social media platforms, and email.

Sharing and/or disseminating private information and information (55%)



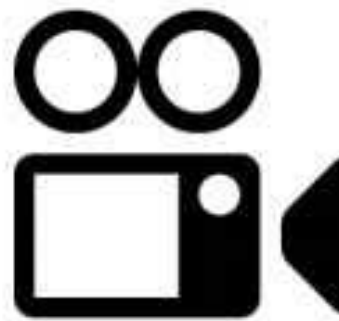
Stealing Identity (28%)
