

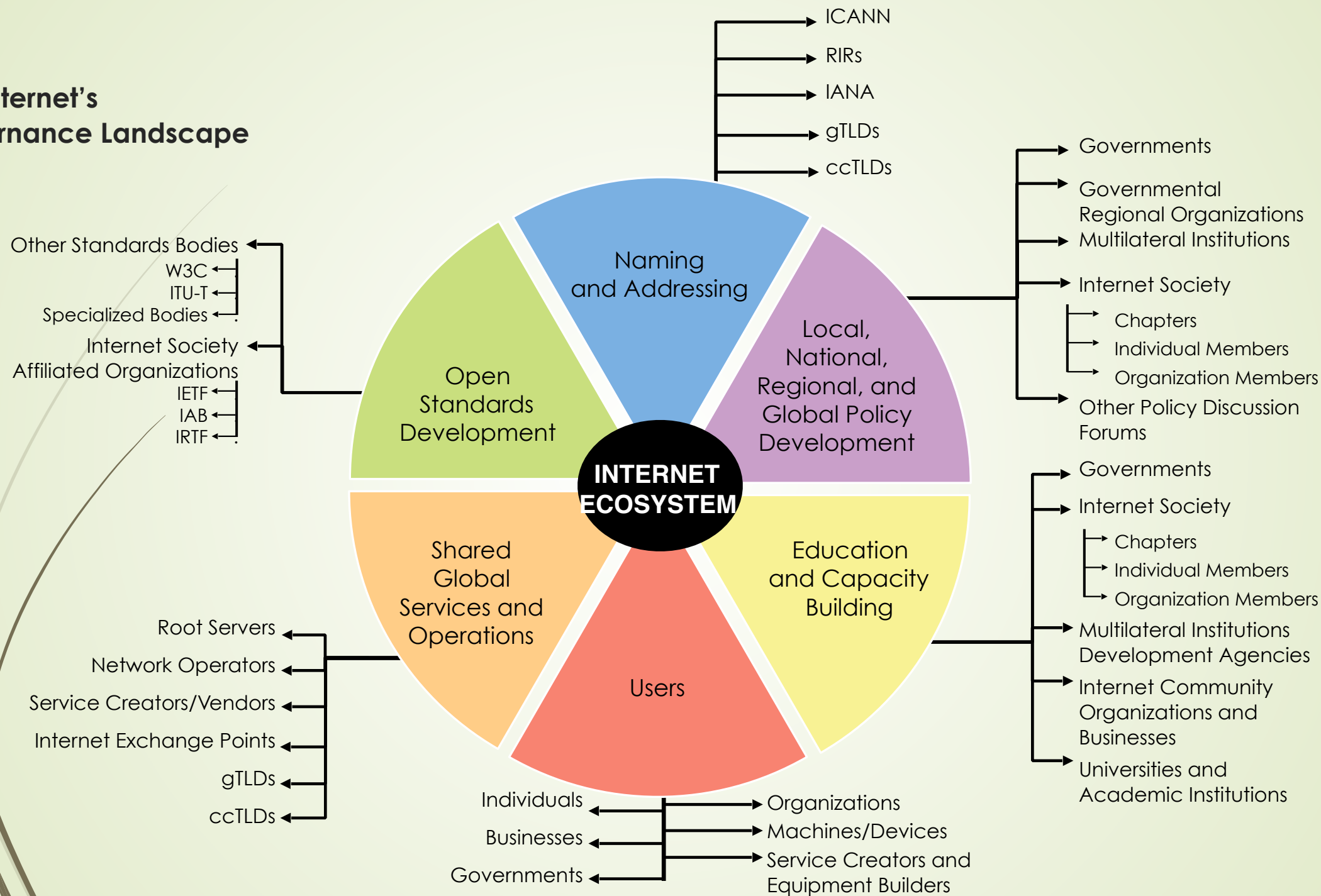


What is Internet Governance?
