Digital national ID issuances hit 10 million, behind target


The Philippine Statistics Authority announced that issuances of the ePhilID have topped 10 million, about half of the target for the year. The PSA's target is to deliver 30 million physical cards and 20 million ePhilIDs by the end of 2022.
